



GAME RULES

Ages 12 to Adult
For 2-4 Players or Teams

THE CONTENTS

600 Questions: 50 Cards each for the following categories: Hall Of Fame, Rock N' Roll Eternity, Disco Purgatory, Real Name, and One Hit Wonder; 100 Cards each for the 50's & 70's categories; and 150 Cards for the 60's category, Game Board, 4 Game Pieces, 1 Die.

OBJECTIVE:

Be the first player to reach and answer a question correctly from the Hall Of Fame category. To reach the Hall Of Fame you must roll the exact number. If you answer incorrectly, you must return to the space you came from and wait for your next turn.

PLAYING THE GAME:

Place the game pieces on LET'S ROCK! (You Roll!). Each player or one player from each team roll the die. Player or Team with the highest number will go first. Continue play in clockwise order.

NOTE: Though the layout of the game path was designed to level the playing field for all ability levels, if agreed upon, feel free to give hints to the less musically inclined players and perhaps challenge the well versed players by NOT reading the multiple choice answers!

Player or Team 1 rolls the die and advances forward that amount. If you land on a category, follow the instructions for that category explained below. You must answer a question correctly to advance on this turn. If you answer incorrectly, play goes to the next player or team. On your next turn, with the exception of *Rock N' Roll Eternity* and *Disco Purgatory*, you do not have to answer a question correctly from the category that you currently occupy to advance. Simply roll the die and continue play.

REST ONE TURN/SKIP ONE TURN/COOL IT:

If you land on any of these spaces do not answer any question, just rest. On your next turn, roll the die and continue play.

ROLLING BACKWARDS:

Move backwards the amount rolled and wait for your next turn, **UNLESS** you are sent into *Disco Purgatory*. If you are sent into *Disco Purgatory* continue play by following the instructions in the *Disco Purgatory* section below. Otherwise, do not answer any questions. On your next turn, roll the die and continue play (You do not have to answer a question on the space you currently occupy).

DISCO PURGATORY

This category covers questions regarding Disco music. If you land on either one of the Disco Purgatory spaces, go to the *Disco Purgatory* area in the body of the guitar. Attempt to answer a question from this category. If you answer correctly, return to the Disco Purgatory space that you came from, roll the die and go **BACK** that amount. Wait for your next turn. On your next turn roll the die and proceed. If you answer incorrectly, wait until your next turn and try again. You are not allowed out of *Disco Purgatory* until you have answered correctly.

ROCK N' ROLL ETERNITY

This category covers questions regarding artists who have passed away. If you land on this space, go to the *Rock N' Roll Eternity* area in the body of the guitar. Attempt to answer a question from this category. If you answer correctly, go to the "Groovy Scene" space on the game board, roll the die and move forward that amount. Continue your turn until you answer a question incorrectly or land on a space that directs you otherwise. You are not allowed out of *Rock N' Roll Eternity* until you have answered correctly.

YOU PICK

Choose any category except *Hall Of Fame*, *Disco Purgatory*, or *Rock N' Roll Eternity*. If you answer correctly, roll the die and continue play until you answer incorrectly or land on a space that directs you otherwise. If you land on Disco Purgatory or Rock N' Roll Eternity, follow the instructions above for that category.

50's - 60's - 70's

The 50's questions range from the mid 50's to the end of the decade. The questions for the 60's and 70's cover the entire decade. If you answer correctly, roll the die and continue play until you answer a question incorrectly or land on a space that directs you otherwise. If you land on Disco Purgatory or Rock N' Roll Eternity, follow the instructions above for that category.

REAL NAMES

Some artists were born with names other than their professional name. This category reveals their true identity. If you answer correctly, roll the die and continue play until you answer incorrectly or land on a space that directs you otherwise. If you land on Disco Purgatory or Rock N' Roll Eternity, follow the instructions above for that category.

ONE HIT WONDER

This category covers questions in which the artist or group made Top 40 pop charts. Some may have charted under another name or with another group, but for this game it will be considered their only hit. If you answer correctly, roll the die and continue play until you answer a question incorrectly or land on a space that directs you otherwise. If you land on Disco Purgatory or Rock N' Roll Eternity, follow the instructions above for that category.

HALL OF FAME

This category covers questions regarding inductees of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. You must roll the **EXACT** number to reach this space (i.e., if you are 3 spaces away and you roll a 4, you must wait until your next turn). If you roll the exact amount, and answer the question correctly - Congratulations! You are the winner! If you answer incorrectly, go back to your previous space and wait for your next turn.
