

REFRAZE™ CHRISTIAN EDITION RULES

For 2 or More Individuals or Teams

OBJECT OF THE GAME: Players must correctly identify the song title from the rephrased title. Example: “Silent Night” is the correct answer to the rephrased title “Quiet Evening”.

START OF PLAY: The first team (or player) selects a card and reads the rephrased title aloud. The other teams must guess the title of the song from the rephrased title. The first team to correctly identify the title receives 10 points. The song’s artist is also included on the card as a hint. If the teams are unable to identify the title, they may ask for the hint to be read aloud. Once the hint is read, the correct answer is worth only 5 points. If no one is able to correctly identify the title in 30 seconds (timer included), then 5 points are awarded to the team reading the question. In the event that more than one team correctly identifies the title at the same time, then points are awarded for each correct answer. The teams take turns selecting and reading the rephrased title cards.

Option: Deduct 5 points for an incorrect answer.

Option: No 30 second time limit.

WINNING THE GAME: Play continues until one of the teams or individuals reaches 100 points.

Option: The game can be played for a predetermined amount of time (example one hour), and the team with the most points at the end of that time is the winner.
