

## Fishin' Game Rules

Game Contents: 36 Cards

(18 Pairs of Cards) and 1 set of rules.

Ages: 3 & Up

Number of Players: 2 to 4

Object: To be the player to collect the most sets of Fish Cards.

**Set Up:** Shuffle the cards. Deal each player five cards face down. Place the remaining cards in a draw pile face down between the players.

## **GAME PLAY:**

Each player may now remove any pairs held in their hand and place them face up in their discard pile. The youngest player will take the first turn and ask one of the other players for a card that matches one in his/her hand. If the player asked has the matching card, she/he must give it to the player who asked for it, the pair is then placed face up in the discard pile. When the player receives a "no" answer, she/he must "go fish" and draw a card from the draw pile. If she/he draws the card asked for, she/he lays down the pair and takes another turn. Any player who runs out of cards may take one from the draw pile when it is his/her turn to play.

## **WINNING:**

The player to collect the most pairs of cards when all the cards are played is the winner!
