



Card Game

RULES

Game Contents: 96 cards, 10 each of numbers 1 through 8 and 16 wild cards

Ages: 4 and up

**Number of
Players:** 2 to 6

Object: To be the first player to play all the cards from their Stock pile



How to Play: Choose a dealer. The dealer shuffles the cards or lays them on a flat surface face down to mix them up. Once the cards are thoroughly mixed the dealer deals each player a stock pile of cards face down as follows:

2 players: 15 cards to each

3 players: 12 cards to each

4 to 6 players: 10 cards to each



(a shorter game can be played by dealing fewer cards to each player)

The dealer then deals 4 additional cards to each player, which becomes the players "Hand".

The four cards of the player's Hand and the top card of the player's stockpile are turned face up.

The cards in front of each player should be laid out like this:



The dealer then sets the balance of the cards aside for future hands. The player to the dealer's left begins.

There ultimately will be 4 and only 4 "Play Piles" of cards in the center of the players. The first player may start one or more Play Piles with a "1" or a Wild Card provided they come from their Hand or the top of their Stock Pile. Cards are then played sequentially, a 2 on top of the one, a 3 on top of the 2, etc., until there are no more plays. If a card is played from the top of the stockpile, turn up the next card on the stockpile



and continue play if possible. The player continues until there are no more plays. The next player repeats the process until they have no plays. Once all players have had their turn the dealer deals 4 more cards to each player. These new cards are placed on top of any existing Hand cards or are placed where Hand cards were in a prior round.

Remember: There can be no more than 4 Play Piles in the center and no more than 4 Hand piles in front of a player.

A Wild Card can be substituted for any number card in a sequence.



When a Play Pile contains 8 cards it is removed from the center of the play area and will be shuffled back into the deck for later use. A new Play Pile is then started in its place.
